

MONTAGUE TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING – NOVEMBER 12, 2019

Art. 1 The meeting is called to order at 7 p.m. by Supervisor King, all Board members present except Korthase who will be here shortly.

Art. 2 Motion by Goodrich, supported by Seaver, to accept the minutes of the October 8 and October 22, 2019 meetings as presented. Motion carried.

Art. 3 Visitors – Ray and Julie Grow had zoning questions. Korthase entered the meeting and stated they will be talking as a Planning Commission to see if some of their zoning questions can be resolved. Ken Mahoney told the Board we have \$3,500 set aside from the senior millage to use for our township's senior citizens.

Art. 4 Clerk Weesies stated that the State is requiring all polling places to have a new computer for the Electronic Poll Book. Weesies will be purchasing a new computer for that purpose soon.

Art. 5 Korthase stated the upper pond at Clear Springs got a new drain inlet to keep logs and debris out of culvert.

Art. 6 We will have John Lipka plow snow at the hall for every 2" of snowfall.

Art. 7 Motion by Korthase, supported by Goodrich, to follow the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Motion carried.

Art. 8 Motion by Goodrich, supported by Korthase, that we don't penalize township residents if they forget to file Homestead Exemption paperwork. Motion carried.
