- Art. 1 The meeting is called to order at 7:00 pm by Supervisor King with all Board members present.
- Art. 2 Motion by Goodrich, supported by Seaver, to approve the minutes of the December 14, 2021, regular meeting as presented. Motion carried.
- Art. 3 Visitors – Linda O’Connell asked about the senior millage money going towards the seniors from Montague Township to use at the Viking Athletic Center in Whitehall. We gave money to the Senior Center in Montague which some of it could be spent at the VAC Center to cover the \$2.00 per visit cost for our seniors.
- Questions were asked about the cell tower on Henderson Road and there is concern over the solar that is going in on Sikkenga Road and future solar in the township.
- Art. 4 ATV’s on township roads was discussed and visitors seemed in favor of this so the Planning Commission will look into it.
- Art. 5 The Masonic Temple is not for sale as this time.
- Art. 6 Motion by Weesies, supported by Seaver, to allow Board members to attend MTA Annual Educational Conference in Lansing. Registration and mileage to be paid by township, motel and meals to be paid by attendees. Motion carried.
- Art. 7 IRS mileage rate is 58.5 cents for 2022.
- Art. 8 King said Board of Review members need to have training this year, more to follow.
- Art. 9 Motion by Goodrich, supported by Korthase, to follow Federal Guidelines for Poverty Exemption. Motion carried.
- Art. 10 It was agreed to have Lipka’s plow the hall and Weesies Brothers plow the two nature centers.
- Art. 11 All Board reports were received for information.
- Art. 12 Motion by Korthase, supported by Goodrich, to pay invoices payable totaling \$32,864.75 (checks 1985 – 2010). Roll call vote taken – all yes. Motion carried.
