- Art. 3 Visitors – Report on senior millage from Commissioner Kim Cyr, Tabor's discussed their neighbor's junk, and Ron Morse talked about his son Phil Morse running for State Representative.
- Art. 4 Motion by Korthase, supported by Goodrich, to support Sports and Shorts at the township park. Our cost would be \$1,625.00. Motion carried.
