- Art. 1 The meeting is called to order at 7 pm by Supervisor King and all Board members are present.
- Art. 2 Motion by Goodrich, supported by Seaver, to approve the minutes of the March 8, 2022, regular meeting as presented. Motion carried.
- Art. 3 Visitors present were given the opportunity to speak. Bruce Froelich is running as a Democrat for County Commissioner. Julie Essenberg spoke regarding Earth Day. Bob Muzio would like to see a lower speed limit on Sikkenga Road because of children playing near the road. The Tabor's spoke of the neighbor's junk. Brenda Rogers has concerns about a trailer on Skeels Road.
- Art. 4 NutriGro will be putting biosolids (sewage sludge) on Bruce Wackernagel 's farm at the corner of Ochs and Fruitvale. The Board has concerns with this and will find out more about it.
- Art. 5 Ray and Julie Grow's building request. Motion by Goodrich, supported by Korthase, to pass the Planning Commission's recommendation to build a garage within 15 ft. of side lot line. Roll call vote taken – all yes. Motion carried.
