

MONTAGUE TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING – SEPTEMBER 13, 2022

- Art. 1 The meeting is called to order by Supervisor King at 7:00 pm with all Board members present.
- Art. 2 Motion by Goodrich, supported by Seaver, to accept the minutes of the August 9, 2022, regular meeting as published. Motion carried.
- Art. 3 Visitors were present, but no one spoke.
- Art. 4 Old business – discussed putting cement at the park shelters, no bids received yet. ORV's using roads is still not finalized but should be soon.
- Art. 5 Motion by Korthase, supported by Goodrich, to pave Lakeshore Drive and Chippewa for a total of \$72,750.00. Roll call vote taken – all yes. Motion carried.
- Art. 6 Motion by Korthase, supported by Goodrich, to pave Weesies Road from intersection Walsh, Weesies, and Fruitvale to Trading Post Road, and pave Walsh Road from expressway northeast to the same intersection for a total of \$185,000.00. Roll call vote taken – all yes. Motion carried.
- Art. 7 WLYS will no longer be cleaning the bathrooms at the soccer field, our park caretaker has agreed to do that work and pay will have to be determined later. Trace Labs will be doing the water testing.
- Art. 8 Muskegon Conservation District will be doing the spraying for phragmites at the Henderson Lake Nature Center for a cost of around \$1,200.00, hoping to control 95% of this grass.
- Art. 9 Cloggers will be using the hall for \$50.00 a night on Mondays instead of Thursdays.
- Art. 10 Montague Township Cemetery was discussed for \$1,900.00 all graves could be found and recorded on a map for future use. More details at a later meeting.
- Art. 11 All Board reports were received for information.
- Art. 12 Motion by Korthase, supported by Seaver, to pay invoices payable totaling \$19,805.63 (checks 2217 – 2241) Roll call vote taken – all yes. Motion carried.
- Art. 13 Motion by Seaver, supported by Goodrich, to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.
- Art. 14 Motion by Seaver, supported by Korthase, to adjourn. Motion carried. The next meeting will be October 11, 2022, at 7:00 pm.
