

MONTAGUE TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING – OCTOBER 11, 2022

- Art. 1 The meeting is called to order by Supervisor Jeff King at 7:00 pm with all Board members present.
- Art. 2 Motion by Goodrich, supported by Seaver, to approve the minutes of the September 13, 2022, regular meeting as presented. Motion carried.
- Art. 3 Some people running for political positions were present to speak to us.
- Art. 4 Julie Essenberg spoke on behalf of the White Lake Climate Action Council.
- Art. 5 Concrete work at the Montague Township Park will be done next year. The ORV Ordinance was discussed but not ready at this time.
- Art. 6 There was discussion regarding the paving of roads. Weesies Road was discussed and MCRC will only pay 25% of the project because they say it's a dead-end road. Whitehall Township was approached for financial assistance, and they said there is no money for this project. Cost will be \$196,000.00. Walsh Road was discussed, and the Board showed no interest to do this road. Weesies stated that if we wait until 2023 the cost for that road will be \$60,000.00 more according to Ken Hulka at MCRC, that means Montague Township will be paying \$30,000.00 more and so will the MCRC be paying \$30,000.00 more. Prices will be higher in 2023, the Board made no decision. Henderson Road was also brought up in the discussion.
- Art. 7 Motion by Korthase, supported by Goodrich, to keep the fire hydrant districts cost the same as last year. Motion carried.
- Art. 8 There will be an audit on our township records on October 19.
- Art. 9 November 8, 2022, we will be holding the General Election here.
- Art. 10 Korthase reported on the Montague Township Cemetery.
- Art. 11 Board reports were received for information
- Art. 12 Motion by Seaver, supported by Weesies, to pay invoices payable totaling \$28,475.88 (checks 2242 – 2269) Roll call vote taken – all yes. Motion carried.
- Art. 13 Motion by Weesies, supported by Goodrich, to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.
- Art. 14 Motion by Weesies, supported by Korthase, to not hold a November meeting because the Election is that day and to pay all invoices due in November, if something comes up a special meeting will be called. Motion carried. The next meeting will be December 13, 2022, at 7 pm.
