

Montague Township Board Meeting – March 14, 2023

Art. 1 The meeting is called to order by Supervisor King, all Board members are present.

Art. 2 Motion by Korthase, supported by Goodrich, to approve the minutes of the February 2023, regular meeting with amendment: Art. 7, should read: to use Federal Poverty Exemption Guidelines and Montague Township Poverty Exemption Guidelines for 2023. Motion carried.

Art. 3 Visitors present – Commissioner Cyr, presented information on the Safe Seniors Program.

Art. 4 Old Business: Goodrich inquired on progress of the junk around houses in the township and the trailers/ houses that should be condemned. King advised he is working on a resolution.

Art. 5 King presented the ORV Ordinance. Motion by Goodrich, supported by Seaver to pass the ORV ordinance 0314-23-ORV. Motion carried.

Art. 6 Korthase presented an estimate from Korthase and Son to change the door locks at the soccer complex and township park restrooms. Seaver requested additional literature on the door lock products.

Art. 7 The board agreed to continue with ~~White Lake Youth Sports~~ ^{CommEd} and to pay ^{shorts} \$1500.00 for the 2023 season.

Art. 8 Korthase provided an update from the planning commission on the solar ordinance and advised good progress is being made.
